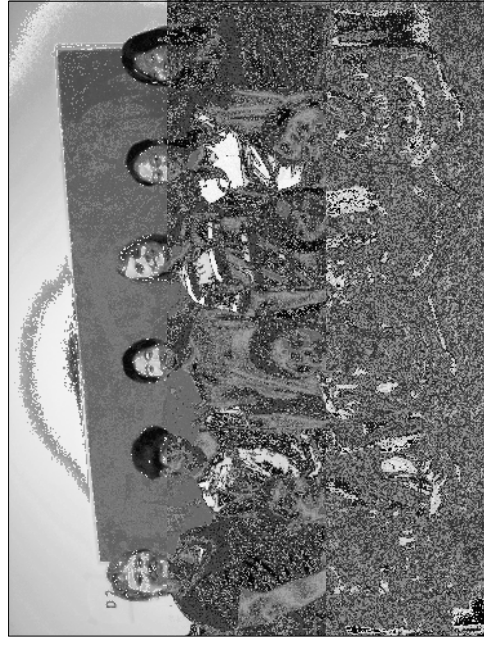

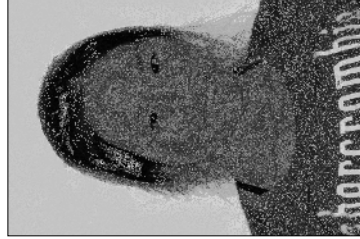
Anna

Anna just finished grade 9 at Riverdale C.I. She hopes to be able to use this experience to share with her non-Christian friends about God and how to help people.



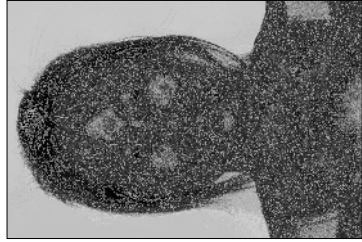
Bianca

Bianca just finished grade 9 at Markville S.S. She hopes to have a good experience and learn about serving people in different ways.



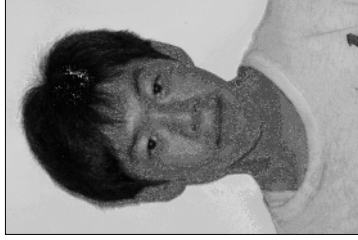
Cynthia

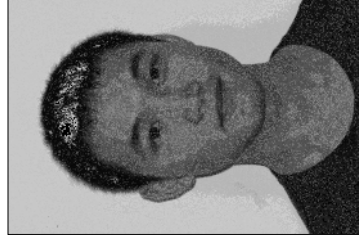
Jeremy
