I wrote an email to her. I told her I also experienced that, the most important thing now is taking care about yourself instead of reaching the high goals. Praise the Lord, her smile is back,,her questions are back and high quality work is back! I know how limited that I did, but God is doing her heartwork. One more time, I don't regret being a teacher:)
