He has a burden to share the gospel with the Chinese people in the Manila area, so he plans to ride a motorbike to go there when he is ready.

My two kids continue their online school at home, they are doing a very good job by God's grace! Hope they can finish this school year well and get ready to go back to their classrooms next school year.
